#### **Part (I): Academic:-**

- (1) To facilitate and familiarize with new syllabus and preparation of Library and Laboratory accordingly.
- (2) To encourage teachers for participation in national/ state/ international level seminars/symposia/ workshop for their development.
- (3) To emphasize on career guidance and placement activities.
- (4) To prepare and implement New Syllabus based on CBCS as per UGC guidelines.
- (5) A new programme M.S.W. is yet awaited for sanction from the university to be started by the institution.

#### **Part (II): Co-curricular and others:-**

- (1) To organize and host an inter-collegiate sports competition.
- (2) To celebrate national festivals to develop national spirit and respect among students
- (3) To strengthen the Parent-Teacher relationship and Alumni Association; and also to utilize their positive suggestions in academic planning.
- (4) To participate in community services with different social activities in collaboration with Government and Non Government Organizations.

### **THE OUTCOME ACHIEVED**

#### **Part (I):-Academic Aspects:-**

- (1) A UGC Sponsored National Seminar on “*Gandhiji and the Concept of Rural Development*” was organized on 10-11 Oct. 2009 with extra ordinary success. A detailed report is placed at another place in this report.
- (2) The teacher’s participation in the seminars for research paper presentation is quite enthusiastic. Most of the faculties have presented or participated in national as well as international seminars during this year.
- (3) The academic calendar prepared in the beginning of the year was implemented successfully without much deviation.
- (4) The campus interviews and the carrier guidance activities were arranged for the student placement. The details are given in the Part B.

### **Part (II):- Co-curricular and other:**

- (1) During this year, a revised syllabus having semester system was implemented in under graduate as well as post graduate programmes, and hence all faculties remained engaged in preparation of new lecture materials and notes.
- (2) Inter-collegiate Kabaddi (Boys) Competition of Saurashtra University – Rajkot was organized and hosted by B.R.S. College- Dumiyani. Detail report is given under activities of the Sports Committee.
- (3) The student participation in sports and cultural competitions was encouraged and they secured different positions at university level. The detail report is given in the respective heads.
- (4) To develop national & social spirit, discipline and respect for cultural heritage among the students, celebration of national and cultural festivals in the campus is the part of the vision and mission of the institution. Celebration of Republic day, Independence day, *Navratri*, *Rakshabandhan(Rakhi)*, *Teachers day*, *Holi&Dhuleti*, *Makersankranti*, etc. have become the part of regular activity of the institution.
- (5) A parent teacher gathering was held on 26<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2009. Parent’s participation was enthusiastic and there were healthy discussion about the student progress.
- (6) The institution is functioning with the vision of rural development, and hence, the participation of the college in social and community services has become a part of its regular activities. These activities are mentioned under the Community Services head.

### **Part (III):-Infrastructure and Administrative Aspects:-**

The Language Laboratory has started functioning with the financial support from Government of Gujarat and the students have started getting advantage of it.

## **PART-B**

### **(1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution.**

Following are the activities reflecting goals and objectives of the institution:-

- (1) The institution is based on the fundamental principles of the *Gandhian* ideology. Hence, the self discipline, self reliance and positive attitude towards labor work are the prime focused area to develop among students. There is a provision for compulsory labor work for all the students.
- (2) Creativity and talents are well nourished by providing the opportunity to participate in the local as well as university level sports and cultural competitions.
- (3) Arrangements of *Gram shibir* and *Khedutshibir* provide opportunity to students to understand and solve the problems of villagers.
- (4) In the new syllabus, the provision of duration of training programme for final year students was changed from three weeks to two weeks duration. Because, the semester system does not allow much flexibility.
- (5) Value based activities of the institution includes: Blood donation, Tree plantation, Rural Health awareness, Swine Flu awareness, Human and Animal Treatment Camps and Child health and Woman Empowerment Camps.
- (6) Student placement and the carrier guidance are also the key area for the institution. Experts from different field of society as well as personnel from employer institutions are invited to address the students.

### **(2) New academic programmes initiated (UGandPG).**

A new academic programme Master of Social Welfare (MSW) could not be initiated due to some sanction problems from the affiliating university.

### **(3) Innovation in curricular design and transaction**

The University has implemented a new syllabus based on semester system, during this year only. Now, it is again asked to prepare and follow a new syllabus based on **CBCS (Choice Based Credit System)** as per the recent recommendations of UGC.

For syllabus reformation the Dean of Saurashtra University- Rajkot, has appointed a **Syllabus Reformation Committee** with following details:

**(3) Examination reforms implemented**

The internal examination structure is as such where as the external examinations are conducted by the affiliating university. Hence, the changes in external examinations made by the university are implemented automatically every time.

**(7) Initiative towards faculty development programme:**

The faculties are entertained a duty leave (DL) when they participate in the seminar/ conference/ workshop for paper presentation or participation. A total of about eighteen papers have been presented in national seminars at different places by the faculties in total. (Annexure-I).

**(9) Citation index of the faculty members and impact factor:**

- Every year student feedback for the proficiency of each teacher is collected. On the basis of student feedback and the management sense it was decided to give the Best Teacher award of this year (2009-2010) to Dr. B.S. Goti, Lecturer- B.R.S. College- Dumiyani.

**(10) Community services:**

The institution carries out different community services through following local committees of the college. The report of activities of all the committees is given below:

**(i) Health committee:-**

1. Health checkup & awareness programme:

- A general health checkup programme was carried out on *15<sup>th</sup> Jul. 2009* for all the students of the college. Dr. Umesh Patel and Dr. L.K. Sadaria provided their services on this day. At the end of the session Dr. Umesh Patel delivered a speech on how to maintain health and sanitation in the hostel.
2. *A Blood Donation camp* was organized in the campus on the 67<sup>th</sup> birth day celebration of the founder & the managing director of the organization on *17<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2009*.
  3. *A Blood Donation camp* was organized at Shree K.N. Patel Vidyalay - Dumiyani on *16<sup>th</sup> December 2009* in collaboration with Shree Kelavni Mandal- Dumiyani and local committee of the college. A total of 71 units of blood were collected by the Dipchand Gardi Blood Bank – Jamnagar.
  4. *A Swine Flu Awareness Programme* was carried on *2<sup>nd</sup> Jan. 2010* at College Campus and Block Health Officer – Dhoraji Dr. Javiya has delivered a very informative speech.
  5. *A Blood Donation camp* was organized at Nani Vavdi- Patel Samaj on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2010 in collaboration with N.S.S. Unit of B.R.S. College- Dumiyani and a total of 65 bottles of blood was collected by Jayshree Blood Bank – Dhoraji.
  6. *A Swine Flu Awareness Rely* was organized on *12<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2010* at Upleta to create awareness about its control measures.
  7. A Lecture on “Present Scenario of Changing Food Habits” was delivered by Mrs. Urvashi Kantariya, Lecturer of Home Science College-Upleta on 4<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2010.

**(ii) Animal Care Committee:-**

- (1) A *Sexual Health Control Camp* for Animals was organized at Dumiyani village on *17<sup>th</sup> July. 2009* in collaboration with ICDP (Intensive Cattle Development Programme), Department of Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Gujarat. A total of 38 animals treated in this camp. Dr. Bhadja, Dr. Goti and Mr. Desai rendered their services in this camp.
- (2) A *Sexual Health Control Camp* for Animals was organized at Nanivavdi village on *11<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2009* in collaboration with ICDP (Intensive Cattle Development Programme), Department of Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Gujarat. A total of 27 animals treated in this camp. Dr. Bhadja, Dr. Goti and Mr. Desai rendered their services in this camp.
- (3) A *Meeting for Animal Owners* was organized at Nanivavdi village on *4<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2010* in collaboration with Animal Husbandry section, District Panchayat- Rajkot. A total of 80 farmers were participated in this meeting. Subject experts from Rajkot Dairy was delivered a very informative speech on the animal rearing.
- (4) A Fertility Improvement Programme (FIP) camp was organized at Nanivavdi village on *18<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2009*, in collaboration with Rajkot Dist. Coop. Milk Prod. Union- Rajkot.
- (5) A Follow up Camp of FIP at Nanivavdi village was arranged on *24<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2009*, in collaboration with Rajkot Dist. Coop. Milk Prod. Union- Rajkot.

**(iii) Agriculture Advisory Committee:-**

- A Farmers Meeting was organized at Nanivavadi village on 8th Jan 2010. A total of 140 farmers participated in the meeting and the subject experts of the college gave very useful information to the farmers.
- A Visit to Junagadh Agriculture University for the students of main subjects of Agronomy, on 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov. 2008.

**(iv) Committee for Khedutshibir and Gramshibir:-**

- A Khedutshibir of 15 students of second year (Krushishikshan) BRS was arranged at Nanivavadi village from 04-01-2010 to 10-01-2010.
- A Gramshibir was also organized during 04-01-2010 to 10-01-2010 where in 15 students of Lokshikshan were placed in their own villages and carried out survey of villagers.

**(v) Child Care & Woman Development Committee:-**

- A Gathering of female students of the college was held on 1<sup>st</sup> Sept.2008 for discussion of self employment of women. Mrs. Bhanuben Chandravadia a member of Vivekanand Trust Samity-Upleta, delivered a speech on current scenario of self employment availability for women. She gave very good information about sewing work, traditional knitting work and how to get employment at one's own home.
- A meeting of village women and female students at Dumiyani village was held on 29<sup>th</sup> Sep.2008. Dr. L.K.Sadaria gave information regarding the women problems related to low hemoglobin in the blood and how to overcome.
- A Seminar on Value Education was held at Saurashtra University campus-Rajkot on 29<sup>th</sup> Jan.2009. A famous speaker and a saint Shree Moraridas Hariyani gave a simple & penetrating speech on the necessity of values in the current form of education. All the girl students of the college have participated in this seminar.

**(vi) Nature and Environment Committee:**

- A Tree Plantation programme was carried out in collaboration with Forest Dept.- Gujarat State and Gram Panchayat Dumiyani and approximately 500 Neem tree plants were planted in the college campus and in surrounding of the Dumiyani village.
- A meeting of famous environment activist Mr. Shamjibhai Antala was arranged in the campus on 12-12-2009 with students and villagers.

**(11) Improvement in the library services:**

**(13) Courses in which student assessment of teachers is introduced and the action taken on student feedback;**

Student feedback forms were given to all the students of final year to give their experience of study, stay, teaching, teacher and the syllabus. The Feedback forms are analyzed and discussed collectively in the common room. All the faculties take initiatives from the discussion and try to improve own self. Moreover, necessary changes in the syllabus or in the other facilities are brought to notice of respective authorities.

**(12) Unit cost of education:**

- (i) Unit cost (including salary) – Rs. 26853.41

**(13) Computerization of administration and the process of admission and examination results, issue of certificates:**

The administration is totally computerized. The final examination is conducted by the affiliating university and hence, the result is also declared by the university. Now semester system has been introduced and hence the internal examination has to be completed as per the stipulated period of a particular component and the result has to declare before the commencement of next component. The degree certificates are issued by the affiliating university.

**(14) Increase in infrastructure facilities:**

The institution received Rupees 2.5 lakh from the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Gujarat, for Furniture and repairing purpose this year.

**(15) Technology up gradation:**

- A Language Lab. is established in the institution, comprising twenty five computer sets. This was funded by Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Gujarat. Now the computer access to faculties as well as to students shall be easier.



- The existing old versions of computers in the administration section are changed to latest versions to ease the working.

**(16) Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students:**

The students have free access to computers during their free periods. Teachers also have same facilities to utilize as and when required.

**(17) Financial aid to students:**

The scholarship and free ship sponsored by the state government and other agencies are handed over to the students. The total amount and its detail are given below:

**(18) Support from the Alumni Association and its activities:**

  - In the presence of the Managing Trustee and all the faculties, parents were asked to discuss about the progress of their son/ daughter, problems if any and the future prospectus of the course.
  - Valuable suggestions from the parents are always of importance from the view of the placement of the students.
- (ii) A Second meeting of parent-teacher association was held on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2010. This meeting was headed by Mr. C.K. Patel, President of World UmiyaPatidar Family- U.S.A.; Honorable Guests Mr. Arvind Patel, Mis. RekhabaSarvaiya- Mamlatdar- Junagadh.

**(20) Health services:**

A clean and healthy surrounding with lush green trees precludes the entry of disease causing enemies in the campus. A health centre is sufficiently equipped to cope of the day today requirements of the campus. Over and above the routine health check-up and treatment, other social health services are also carried out through the Health Committee of the college.

A general health check-up programme for all the students is followed in the beginning of the academic session.

- (iv)Personality Development and Carrier Guidance programmes are routinely held in the campus. Renowned persons from the different fields are invited to deliver their speech. Details are given in respective heads.
- (v) A strong linkage has been established with many employer and trainer institutions. This provides optimum opportunities for the placement of graduate students.
- (vi)Consultancy services are provided free of cost to villagers of the surrounding areas by the faculty members. This includes problems related to Agriculture, Animal husbandry, Horticulture, Soil & water testing; Milk testing, Health care, etc.
- (vii) Academic calendar is prepared in the beginning of the year and is followed as such.
