Detail plans of the institution for the year 2012-2013

Part (I): Academic:-

- (1) To prepare for the reaccreditation of the institution.
- (2) To prepare academic calendar in coordination with the affiliating university and let honestly follow the same as far as possible without much deviation.
- (3) To encourage teachers for participation in national/ state/ international level seminars/symposia/ workshop for their development.
- (4) To encourage teachers to participate in seminars related to research methodology and how to carry out research projects.
- (5) To emphasize on career guidance and placement activities and strengthening of alumni association.
- (6) To implement and prepare course materials as per New Syllabus based on CBCS as per UGC guidelines consecutively in the next semesters.
- (7) A new programme M.S.W. is yet awaited for sanction from the university to be started by the institution.

Part (II): Co-curricular and others:-

- (1) To celebrate national festivals to develop national spirit and respect among students.
- (2) To strengthen the Parent-Teacher relationship and Alumni Association; and also to utilize their positive suggestions in academic planning.
- (3) To participate in community services with different social activities in collaboration with Government and Non Government Organizations.
- (4) To emphasize on value education by organizing and inviting personals from related fields and arrange discussion with students and faculties.

Part (III):-Infrastructure and Administrative Aspects:-

- (1) New buildings for Seminar Hall, Laboratory and Library have been started for construction after approval from UGC. It will be soon completed.
- (2) Management has decided to spare lacking funds in construction of UGC granted Seminar hall, Library and Laboratory buildings.

THE OUTCOME ACHIEVED

Part (I):-Academic Aspects:-

- (1) The teacher's participation in the seminars for research paper presentation is quite enthusiastic. Most of the faculties have presented or participated in national as well as inter-national seminars during this year.
- (2) The semester system has made a cent percent involvement of the students in academic calendar because this is a continuous learning and evaluation process.
- (3) The academic calendar prepared in the beginning of the year was implemented successfully without much deviation.
- (4) The campus interviews and the carrier guidance activities were arranged for the student placement. The details are given in the Part B.
- (5) Coaching classes for entry in services have been started as per UGC guidelines in the second half of the year.

Part (II):- Co-curricular and other:

- (1) As per guidelines of UGC the new choice based credit system has been implemented by the affiliating university, hence the same new syllabus is implemented consecutively.
- (2) A revised syllabus having semester system (CBCS) was implemented consecutively in third year also and hence all faculties remained engaged in preparation of new lecture materials and notes.
- (3) The student participation in sports and cultural competitions was encouraged and they secured different positions at university level. The detail report is given in the respective heads.
- (4) To develop national & social spirit, discipline and respect for cultural heritage among the students, celebration of national and cultural festivals in the campus is the part of the vision and mission of the institution. Celebration of Republic day, Independence day, *Navratri, Rakshabandhan(Rakhi), Teachers day, Holi & Dhuleti, Makersankranti, etc.* have become the part of regular activity of the institution.
- (5) A parent teacher gathering was held on 26th Jan. 2012. Parent's participation was enthusiastic and there were healthy discussion about the student progress. This type of gathering is also a part of regular activity of the institution.
- (6) The institution is functioning with the vision of rural development, and hence, the participation of the college in social and community services has become a part of its regular activities. These activities are mentioned under the Community Services head.

Part (III):-Infrastructure and Administrative Aspects:-

- (1) To develop proficiency in English language among student, extra English coaching has also been started in the Language Laboratory over and above regular classes.
- (2) The institution has spared lacking funds from its own resources for construction of UGC granted Seminar hall, Library and Laboratory buildings.

PART-B

(1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution.

Following are the activities reflecting goals and objectives of the institution:-

- (1) The institution is based on the fundamental principles of the *Gandhian* ideology. Hence, the self discipline, self reliance and positive attitude towards labor work are the prime focused area to develop among students. There is a provision for compulsory labor work for all the students. Tree plantation and maintenance, campus cleanliness work, subject related extension/ consultancy work, program management and organization of functions by students are some of the examples.
- (2) Creativity and talents are well nourished by providing the opportunity to participate in the local as well as university level sports and cultural competitions.
- (3) Arrangements of *Gram shibir* and *Khedutshibir* provide opportunity to students to understand the problems and to some extent solve the problems of villagers.
- (4) Value based activities of the institution includes: Blood donation, Tree plantation, Rural Health awareness, Swine Flu awareness, Human and Animal Treatment Camps and Child health and Woman Empowerment Camps.
- (5) Student placement and the carrier guidance are also the key area for the institution. Experts from different field of society as well as personnel from employer institutions are invited to address the students.

(2) New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG).

A new academic programme Master of Social Welfare (MSW) could not be initiated due to some sanction problems from the affiliating university.

(3) Innovation in curricular design and transaction

1. The CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) is already implemented in first and second year BRS program and subsequently shall be implemented in the third year.
2. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in MRS program is being prepared to implement from the next academic year as per guidelines of affiliating university.

(4) Examination reforms implemented.

The internal evaluation structure in CBCS courses involves a continuous evaluation process. There are three components each with 10 marks out of total 30 marks. They are as follows:

- (i) An assignment comprising 10 marks
- (ii) A written quiz comprising 10 marks
- (iii) A comprehensive test comprising 10 marks

The rest 70 marks are allotted for Semester End Examination which is conducted by affiliating university for a course of 100 marks.

(5) Initiative towards faculty development programme:

The faculties are entertained a duty leave (DL) when they participate in the seminar/ conference/ workshop for paper presentation or participation. A total of about eighteen papers have been presented in national seminars at different places by the faculties in total. (Annexure-I)

(6) Total number of seminars / workshops conducted:

Due to over work load to most of faculties and implementation of CBCS course, workshop or seminars could not be arranged this year.

(7) Citation index of the faculty members and impact factor:

Every year student feedback for the proficiency of each teacher is collected. On the basis of student feedback and the management sense it was decided to give the Best Teacher award of this year (2011-2012) to Dr. D. C. Patel, Lecturer- B.R.S. College- Dumiyani.

(7) Community services:

The institution carries out different community services through following local committees of the college. The report of activities of all the committees is given below:

i. Health committee:-

1. Health checkup & awareness programme:

A general health checkup programme was carried out on 30th Jul. 2011 for all the students of the college. Dr. Divyesh Parmar and Dr. L. K. Sadaria provided their services on this day. At the end of the session Principal Dr. M. G. Kalavadia delivered a speech on how to maintain health and sanitation in the hostel.

2. A Blood Donation camp was organized in the campus on the 69th birth day celebration of the founder & the managing trustee of the organization on 17th Oct. 2011. A total of 85 persons donated blood in this camp. Nathani Voluntary Blood Bank- Rajkot has participated in this camp.

3. A Vyasana Mukti Shapath Samaroh was organized at Ashramshala- Dumiyani on 17th Oct. 2011 on the occasion of Birthday celebration of Managing Trustee Shree B.B. Manavar. Mr. Vikram Madam- M.P.-Jamnagar and Mr. Gordhan Jadafiya- Ex. Minister & MLA- Gujarat encouraged the students to be free from bad habits like smoking, tobacco chewing, etc. and be healthy and make the nation healthy.

4. World AIDS Day Celebration was organized on the college campus on 1st Dec. 2011. Dr. R. K. Dalsania MS- Upleta delivered a speech on how to control AIDS.

5. A One day Sanitation and Health Campaign was organized at Bhankh village on 8th Jan 2012, in collaboration with N.S.S. Unit of B.R.S. College- Dumiyani.

6. One day Yoga and Dhyana Shibir was arranged at college campus on 21st Jan 2011. Dr. Anita Katariya- Lecturer at Ayurved College- Junagadh addressed the students to encourage them for importance of Yoga in day to day life.

(ii) Animal Care Committee: -

(1) A Sexual Health Control Camp for Animals was organized at Dumiyani village on 25th August 2011 in collaboration with ICDP (Intensive Cattle Development Programme) sub centre- Dumiyani, Department of Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Gujarat. A total of 31 animals treated in this camp. Dr. Bhadja (Veterinary Officer) Dr. Goti and Mr. Ishvar Desai rendered their services in this camp.

(2) A Sexual Health Control Camp for Animals was organized at Dumiyani village on 14-08-2011 in collaboration with ICDP (Intensive Cattle Development Programme), Department of Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Gujarat. A total of 25 animals treated in this

camp. Dr. Bhadja (Veterinary Officer), Dr. Goti and Mr. Desai rendered their services in this camp.

- (3) A Meeting for Animal Owners was organized at Bhankh village on 7th Jan.2012 in collaboration with Animal Husbandry Department, District Panchayat- Rajkot. A total of 52 farmers were participated in this meeting. Subject expert from Animal Husbandry Department, District Panchayat- Rajkot has delivered a very informative speech on the animal rearing.
- (4) "A Veterinary Camp" was organized at- Byhankh village (Tal- Upleta) on 7th Jan.2012 in collaboration with Department of Animal Husbandry, Govt. of Gujarat.

(iv) Committee for Khedutshibir and Gramshibir:-

(b) A Gramshibir was also organized during 27-12-2011 to 02-01-2012 where in 52 students of Lokshikshan were placed in 25 different villages comprising groups of two students and carried out survey of villagers.

The main activities during this program include:

2. Playing child game with students of std. 1 to 7 of the village school
3. Village cleanliness program involving villagers too
4. Farm visits to farmers farm and to know the farmers problems
5. Farmers meeting with Agriculture experts
6. Awareness campaign for child education, women awakening, importance of cleanliness, group tasks, women and child health, health and education.

(v) Child Care & Woman Development Committee:-

1. On date 15/09/2011, the girls students of the college have participated in the 43th Youth Festival of Upleta Block held in Vividlaxi Vinaymandir -Upleta. Especially in the competitions like of dance, chorus, folk-song, marriage-song, debate and of gazelles- the girl students of our college have acquired the first, second and third rank accordingly. In the same festival, Prof. K.R. Bharad, Prof. I.K. Sama and Prof. P.R. Khant have remained present and have given guidance to the students.
2. In the programs held under the head Swarnim Saptadhara, at Matushri Virbai Mahila College at Rajkot, the girl students have participated in the competitions like folk-song and chorus and have acquired the first, second and third rank accordingly. Prof. V.B. Goswami and Prof. P.R. Khant remained present during the program me for promoting the girls.
3. A program was arranged in the college so as to provide different in formations & skills like how to make different dishes and of things for home-adorations, from waste to best & etc. under the leadership of Prof. Asshaben Patel, Dept of Home science, Bhalodiya Mahila College, Rajkot. She has given interesting information in detail to the girl students of the college and of the Dumiyani village.

(vi) Nature and Environment Committee:

4. Well known spiritual and with rich bio-diversity: the Girnar mountain in Junagadh district, was visited by nature and environment committee on 25 Dec 2011. Student with faculty Dr. K. R. Bharad, Dr, R. B. Ubhadia and Dr .D. C. Patel enjoy the tour with informal education of awareness of plant spices.
5. To develop creativity in student an exhibition was arranged in college on 21 Jan.2012. Beautiful posters, slogans were made by F.Y.B.R.S Student.

(10) Improvement in the library services:

(12) Courses in which student assessment of teachers is introduced and the action taken on student feedback;

Student feedback forms were given to all the students of final year to give their experience of study, stay, teaching, teacher and the syllabus. The Feedback forms are analyzed and discussed collectively in the common room. All the faculties take initiatives from the discussion and try to improvise own self. Moreover, necessary changes in the syllabus or in the other facilities are brought to notice of respective authorities.

(13) Unit cost of education:

(14) Computerization of administration and the process of admission and examination results, issue of certificates:

The administration is totally computerized. The final examination is conducted by the affiliating university and hence, the result is also declared by the university. Now semester system has been introduced and hence the internal examination has to be completed as per the stipulated period of a particular component and the result has to declare before the commencement of next component. The degree certificates are issued by the affiliating university.

(15) Increase in infrastructure facilities:

- Addition and repairing of desks, benches and tables done as per requirements.

(16) Technology up gradation:

- Students identification is made online after enrollment by taking their photographs through web-cam.
- The existing old versions of software in computers of the administration section are changed to latest versions to ease the working.

(17) Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students:

The students have free access to computers during their free periods. Teachers also have same facilities to utilize as and when required.

(18) Financial aid to students:

The scholarship and free ship sponsored by the state government and other agencies are made available to the students. The total amount and its detail are given below:

Manvar, Trustee Mrs. Savitaben Manvar and all the faculties. Parents were asked to discuss about the progress of their son/ daughter, problems if any and the future prospectus of the course.

- The Chief Guest Dr. V. A. Nandania, Principal- Municipal Arts and Commerce College- Upleta, gave a very good speech on the responsibilities of parents and teacher to shape the carrier of students.

- Valuable suggestions from the parents are always of importance from the view of the placement of the students.

(21) Health services:

A clean and healthy surrounding with lush green trees precludes the entry of disease causing enemies in the campus. A health Centre is sufficiently equipped to cope of the day today requirements of the campus. Over and above the routine health check-up and treatment, other social health services are also carried out through the Health Committee of the college.

A general health check-up programme for all the students is followed in the beginning of the academic session.
